New This Year - MAP Growth Testing

The diocese has made a significant change, beginning this year, with how our students will be tested and their progress tracked. We will no longer be taking the Terra Nova/In View tests in March. Instead, we will be testing our third through seventh grade students three times a year using MAP Growth testing. We will test in the fall, beginning later next week, in the winter some time in January, and again in the spring. Testing will take place during student's computer class as it is an online test, each test taking approximately one hour. (English, math, and reading) The information gathered from this testing program will be invaluable for our school,

our individual teachers, our students, and you - their parents. More information will be forthcoming as we prepare to make this welcomed change for the continued success of our school.

Our 8th grade students will be taking the PSAT/8. These test scores will better help with high school placement, as well as begin to prepare our students for the PSAT and SAT exams.
