

Grade 2 Supply List

- 2 packages No. 2 pencils (plain yellow, no designs)
- 1 pair of scissors (children's pointed)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 box of crayons (no more than 16 count) LABEL
- 4 glue sticks or 2 large sticks
- 2 boxes of washable classic color markers (thick) LABEL
- 1 Marble Composition Notebook (black hardcover)
- 1 watercolor washable paint set with brush (8 color set) LABEL
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 box of baby wipes
- 1 container of Clorox type wipes
