## Summer Reading Program

### Grade 3

#### 1. Choose one of the following books to read:

1. *Stone Fox* by John Gardiner
2. *Ramona The Pest* by Beverly Cleary
3. *Mr. Popper's Penguins* by Richard and Florence Atwater

I would like you to construct a **"diorama"** out of a shoe box. Inside the box should be a scene showing an important part from the book. Be sure to label your scene. On the top of your diorama, you should put the title of the book, the author, and your name. One side panel on the outside of the box you should give a list of the book's characters. On the other side panel, give the setting of the story and whether or not you liked the book and why. Lastly, on the back of the box, write down the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Each one of these should be 3 sentences long or more.

#### 2. Read one non-fiction book of your choice

Read one non-fiction book this summer on a topic of interest to you or something you have always wanted to know more about. Please do not choose a biography book since we will be doing one of these book reports during the year. Your book report should be 2 pages. The first page should be a cover including the name of the book, the author, your name, and a detailed illustration about the book. The second page should list 4 interesting things you learned from reading the book. Please be sure to write down your information in complete sentences.
